

## **Sydney Eisteddfod Video Submission Guidelines**

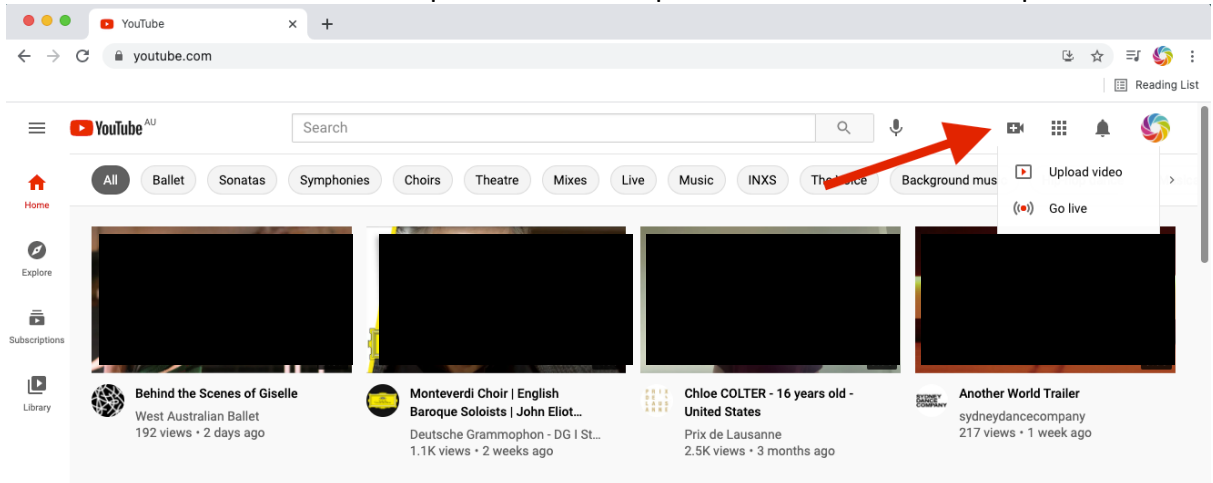
1. Video must be one continuous take with no pauses, stoppages or cuts.
2. No editing/effects or other manipulation of the video is permitted. Sydney Eisteddfod reserves the right to disqualify an entrant if such edits are apparent.
3. Only one Camera will be allowed to film. The use of two or more cameras is prohibited.
4. Camera must be fixed, and all musicians/choristers must be visible in the video frame.
5. Only the microphone on the recording device (i.e., iPhone or video camera) should be used. No additional microphones will be permitted to enhance sound. No sound mixing should be done live or after recording.
6. Please make sure to video in landscape for optimal viewing.
7. Please note that entries will not be judged on the quality of video. Entrants are encouraged to provide the best quality video they can, with the equipment available to them. Professionally recorded videos are not required.
8. You are welcome to submit your video earlier than the submission date, however all videos must be submitted by Friday 11 June 2021 or risk disqualification.
9. Videos are only to be submitted ONCE. No changes can be made once video has already been submitted, so check over all details carefully.
10. Any form of cheating, as deemed by the Eisteddfod, will result in disqualification.
11. Performance must be performed and recorded by the entrant/s in the 2021 Calendar year.
12. At the start of the video, we ask that you announce:
  - a. Your entrant number and ensemble name.
  - b. The event number you are competing in
  - c. The name of the pieces you are playing
13. This announcement can be made by either a playing student or the conductor and will not be counted towards your time limit.
14. Video will be viewed only by adjudicator/s and Eisteddfod staff.
15. All individual category rules and conditions still apply, so make yourself familiar with these.

### **Uploading your completed video to YouTube.**

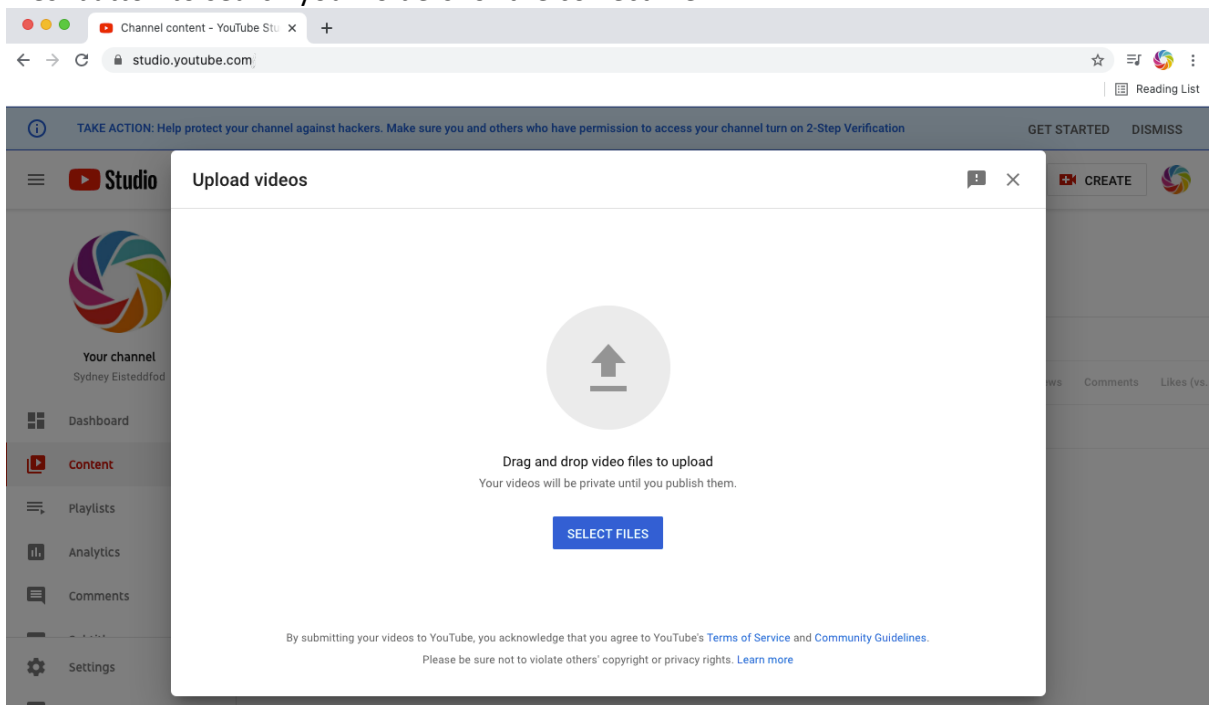
We will be accepting your videos via YouTube link. It is very important to ensure when uploading your video to YouTube to select 'unlisted' in the privacy settings. This means that no one can access your video unless they are provided with the direct link. An unlisted video will not appear on YouTube search results, your channel, or the home page.

## How to Upload to YouTube from a Web Browser

1. Navigate to [www.youtube.com](http://www.youtube.com)
2. If you don't already have an account, you will first have to set up an account.
3. Once logged in, find the upload video button on the top right-hand corner, this should look like a camera with a plus button on top. Click this and then click 'upload'



4. You can now either drag and drop your video file on to the 'arrow' or use the 'select files' button to search your folders for the correct file.



5. Once you have chosen your file, it will ask you to fill out the details for the video. Please follow the following format for the title of the video:
  - a. Event Number – Entrant Number – Ensemble Name.
  - b. Once details have been appropriately filled out, click NEXT.

6. You should then come to the 'visibility' screen. This is most important when uploading your video. Please ensure you click **UNLISTED**. If you click private we will not be able to view your video. Once you click unlisted, click SAVE.

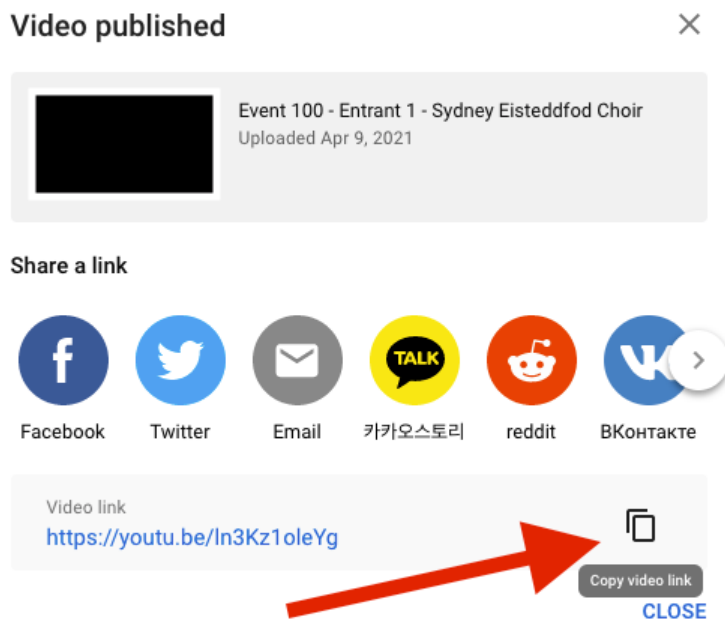

8. Please note: New YouTube users who have skipped user verification will have their video length limited to 15 minutes. Please make sure to verify your Google Account, if submitting longer videos.

- A PDF copy of all the scores for the adjudicator. With all details clearly marked.

If submitting multiple entries, please follow the same format for each entry. It is recommended that multiple entries are submitted in the same email but please be sure to outline the correct details above PER ENTRY. It is your responsibility to ensure all details are correct and all links are in working order.

### Before clicking 'SEND' please double check that:

- The videos are correctly set as 'unlisted'.
- You have copied the correct link and that the link works.
- You have completed all details PER ENTRY.
